I was born and raised on the
head of the Right Hand Fork of

going up. It was about 6-8 miles
above Raccoon Cr.

My father's name was Andrew
Washington Gilkinson, called A. W.
Gilkinson.

My mother was ~~Jane~~ Matilda
Jane Caylor, dau. of Joel and
~~Martha~~ ~~Phelps~~ Martha Ann ("Patsy")
Phelps. My grandfather Caylor
went to Minnesota (with Caleb Clay)
in ~~a~~ covered wagons. Both
grandmother Caylor & grand father
Caylor died out there. The Caylor
had 2 daus. & 4 sons. All moved
to Minnesota. All are dead but
Uncle Jim, who now lives in
