CAPTAIN ANDREW HATFIELD AND HIS DESCENDENTS.

Andrew Hatfield was believed to have been born in England about the year of 1730. The date he came to America is not known, but he settled in Giles County Virginia. He served as Captain in the Virginia Militia in Montgomery County, which adjoins Giles County, just after the Revolution.

Records show that on September 15, 1802 Andrew Hatfield of Montgomery County Virginia, purchased from David McComas "of Kanawha County Virginia," (Cabell County then being a part of Kanawha) a tract of 576 acres of land on the Guyan River in what is now Cabell County, West Virginia. In 1803 Andrew Hatfield purchased another 276 acres of the same farm known as the Stephen Wilson patent, now known as Roach, W. Va. Also the Mathers farm, here he lived until his death.

In the Hatfield Cemetery at Inez, W. Va. his monument stands fittingly marked as a Captain of the Revolutionary War, making this generation eligible to join the Son's and Daughter's of the Revolutionary War.

Records in the County Court Clerk's Office in Huntington, W. Va. shows that at least four sons of Andrew Hatfield came to Cabell County, and the farm was deeded to John, William, Thomas and Adam.

Adam Hatfield (born Oct. 19, 1774.) Died June 18, 1855. Was married to Mary Williams (born Feb. 12, 1782.) on Dec. 3, 1799. She was of dutch descent and spoke English very brokenly.

MOSES HATFIELD AND HIS DESCENDENTS,

Moses Hatfield (born July 25, 1822.) Died Feb. 17, 1895. Married Peninah Beckett (born Oct. 5, 1820.) Died Jan. 5, 1878. They had four sons and four daughters.

Moses and Peninah lived at what is now known as Inez, W. Va. (Roach) about six miles up the river from Barboursville, W. Va.

They lived in a two story log house on the bank not far from the river, this spot is well remembered by some of the older generation now living. Here they reared their eight children. Adam and Emily died at an early age and as most of the early descendents are buried in the Hatfield Cemetery at Inez, W. Va.

After the death of Peninah his wife, he lived with his children for a while and then moved to Barboursville, W. Va. and remarried Mrs. S. E. A. Sidebottom on Dec. 1, 1884, there he lived until his death.

Martha Ann married Adam Hinchman a Veteran of the Civil War. They moved down the Guyan River about a mile to live in a little log house on the Dial farm, they lived there only a few years and then moved on down the river a little ways to what was known as the Morris Bend, there they built a two story frame house.

He and his family made their living by farming and raising watermelons which the sons hauled over the nearby neighborhood to sell.

Martha Ann and two of her daughters and one son died there and was buried in the Hatfield Cemetary at Inez, W. Va. Not long after this because of Adam's ill health the farm was sold and he was moved on a cot to his son's home in Wayne County, where he died. His body was brought back and buried by Martha Ann.

Albert W. married Emily Susan Payne and moved on part of his fathers farm alloted to him. The house was a story and a half log house with a kitchen and dining room built on out of rough planks running up and down, it had a large wood burning fire place where meals were frequently cooked. The house stands today and but for a few minor changes looks much the same, and the old well is still supplying water. The hickory nut trees that surrounded the house many are still there and are still bearing.

The large oak tree that stands out from the front of the house still looks inviting for another swing made from a split pole hung by a chain and hanging from one of its big branches.

Here Albert lived untill his death. Emily died many years later at her son's home at Roach, W. Va. They also lie in the Hatfield Cemetary.

They had four sons and four daughters which were brought up in a home where family prayer was offered daily, their home was a haven for preachers of all faith's, and the intertaining of strangers.

Joseph W. married Roxie Mathers Price. They had five daughters. Not much is known of his family. In 1902 he moved to Greensburg, Ind. and there made his home, occasionally coming back to Inez, W. Va. for a visit. One of his daughters lives in Cincinnati, Ohio. and the rest in and around Greensburg. They both died and are buried there.

James C. married Mary M. Semonds and they lived in his fathers log house, but later tore it down and built a two story eight room house. He farmed for some years and later built a general merchandise store which he ran for a good many years, which was also run by three other descendents that lived there later.

In 1900 the C&O Railroad built a tract following the Guyan River from Barboursville to Logan, W. Va. giving them train stop also mail service, the Post Office being in his store. For many years the Old as well as the Young people gathered at the station on Sunday afternoons to watch the passenger train go by, and many times going aboard the train long enough to buy some of the delicies the news boys would have to sell. Not having a name for the Post Office he decided to name it Inez after his eldest daughter.

Lucinda and Hannah never married and lived with them untill Hannah's death. Lucinda died many years later at the home of a niece in Huntington, W. Va. but they both lie together in the Hatfield Cemetary.

In 1915 James and his wife moved to Huntington, W. V a. where he went into road construction work which after his death two of his sons carried on as The Hatfield Construction Co. untill their deaths, Mary died only a few years ago at the home of a daughter who lives near the Mt. Pisgah Church. You will find their graves along with one son and one daughter in the Hatfield Cemetary which he donated the ground.

They had four sons and four daughters.

A few years ago the house in which they lived burned to the ground leaving a vacant space where the old log house stood in which the Moses Hatfield generation started, with nothing but a few old trees as a memorial.

The Mt. Pisgah Methodist Church still stands on the hill comonly known as Niger Hill, the older members of the Mose Hatfield generation have spent many happy hours there. Some helped to build the church, others were teachers and leaders in the church. Some of the descendents are still leaders and attendents.
