Virginia Campbell-Turner Named Employee of the Year

Virginia Campbell-Turner, Purchasing Agent in the Purchasing Department, has been named the Marshall University Employee of the Year for 2007. President Stephen J. Kopp presented the award and several gifts to her in a ceremony on June 5.

An employee since September, 1985, she was nominated by Karen Barker of the Center for the Advancement of Teaching and Learning and was selected as the Employee of the Month for November 2007.

Commenting on her experience with Campbell-Turner, Barker said she nominated her for the award because of Campbell-Turner's ever-present willingness to assist her when she had a purchasing question.

"Virginia was always available to answer these questions. When I called with procedural

In Memoriam: Dr. Lee Erickson

Dr. Lee E. Erickson, Professor of English who specialized in British literature, died suddenly May 27 in New York City at the age of 55. He was spending the academic year on sabbatical in New York while researching the Romantic poets.

Erickson attended Yale University (B.A. 1973) and UCLA (Ph.D. 1980), and had taught at Marshall since 1981.

He is survived by his wife, Ellen Martin; his mother; two sisters; and several cousins, nieces and nephews. A memorial service will take place on the Huntington campus in Huntington in September at a date and time to be announced.
