Finished 1st officers' Train-  
ing came there, then went  
to Camp Crane, Allentown  
Pa. Dressed men there  
for gas warfare. Then  
was attached to U.S. Hospital  
68 of the regular army,  
all during World War. Went  
over seas with a part  
of 79th Division of Pa.  
Said there 17 mos. Rec'd  
the patients from the  
Chateau Thierry drive.

Dr. Jennings:

Three brothers, Jonathan,
