Sherd Adkins who m. Christena Adkins, his first cousin, was a brother to Berry, etc. but was too young to be in the Rev. War.

Mary Adkins mother of Jacob Sr., Sherd, and (David $\frac{1}{2}$ bro.) took her children and went to Maryland to keep Jacob out of the army. Sherd was too young. A son, Mark, was hung probably by the British during the Revolution. The father of Sherd & Jake Christena & Nanna (Lilleberri's wife) was Jacob Oxford.

Berry A. Sr. had a nephew Berry A. son of old David Adkins, who lived on Berry's Br. way up on W. Fork of Mud River above Hamiltons.

Rev. A. J. Adkins was a Primitive Baptist preacher.

Jesse Adkins nicknamed "Brulbuck", was a son of Littleberry Sr.

William Adkins, son of Rev. Hezekiah Adkins Sr., came in 1806. Then returned with his family, and Hughey Bowen, his brother-in-law. He had married Cinderella Bowen, sister to Hughey Bowen. See her tombstone just below Jim Morrison's store. When he returned to Va., he told his folks about the papas in this country. When he came down New River, the Indians followed them down past Charleston. They wanted to steal their horses. The Indians then learned about their discovery & turned up Elk River.

buried on the Ira Gilkerson farm about two miles above Raccoon Cr. on the left going down Beech Fork

Owen Adkins, son of Fat Jesse, owned the mill at Dixon, at time of his death.

Nanna Adkins wife of Lulleberry Sr. was a sister of Sherd & Jacob Adkins Sr & David Adkins.

Millington Adkins Sr. was a first cousin to Sherd Sr., Jake, & David, etc. Christena Adkins was a sister to Sherd, etc. Also Nanna A. who m. Lulleberry Sr. Christena married Sherd B. Adkins. They were first cousins, because Sherd B's father was Parker V. Adkins, and Christena's mother (& Sherd's also) was Mary Adkins.

Billy ("Sleepy Billy") & wife Magdalena Bowyer Adkins are buried in the cemetery below Jim Morrison's.

Wash Adkins lived at Wayne
till he left his wife. He then
came to Neslo on Beech Fork
and ran a store & died there
His wife was another man's wife
& his people didn't like it.

Rev. Gerard Adkins, a Camp-
bellite preacher was a son.

He ~~is~~ dead. A dau. of
Wash m. a Davis. Another
son got drunk & was drowned
at Huntington.

Jake Adkins Sr. first came to the Huntington bottoms about where Marshall College stands, in 1806, and built a log cabin on the knoll there, but soon sold it for a horse, saddle, bridle & a gun, and came to the mouth of Long Br. on Beech Fork & took up land where "Fonso" Adkins, now lives, son of Johnson & Zelitha Morrison Adkins (daughters James & Frances), at Bowen 3 miles below Morrison's store.

He sold it to a man named Boolean - Reuben Boolean, father of Asa Boolean. Jefferson B. Bowen killed himself here. He m. Martha Boolean, daughter of Reuben B. & sister of Asa Boolean.

Edmund Ferguson left here and went to what is now Council Bluffs, Iowa & took a claim & sold it.

A man Stokes (Brice), uncle to Edmund Ferguson, went there. Enoch Adkins, brother to Lamech A. Sr. & Billy Jo etc. went to Council Bluffs, then, Missouri & never returned.

Enoch A. came back only once
to see his father & mother,
"Sleepy Billy" who m. Bowen,
sister to Hughey Bowen.

Enoch m. a dau. of this
man Stokes. Enoch had a
son, William Adkins, 12 years old
when his father left here with
him. He returned 52 years later
& knew the place 1895.

Two of his uncles Lamech, &
