My first school was to Frank  
Herridon in the hollow on Asa  
Wilson's, next to the Jas. Dundas  
place. This was a log school.  
I was 6 yrs. old. My uncles  
Tom, Alex, Brud Harshbarger  
Ed Judley, Morris Nipps, went  
there. Used long seats, and  
reclation seats. Burned wood.  
Allan Harrison went to school
