Lilleberg Adkins Sr. had a mill in Virginia. He had a son, Owen Adkins, who ran a mill in Virginia, for his father, but took a cold and died, and told his father never to let any of his brothers run a mill.

Fat Jesse died after the Civil War. He was a brother to Priscilla Adkins Fry, grand mother of Everett and Columbus Cole. Everett Cole says he remembered seeing Jesse Adkins about 1863. His father took him to Wayne.

## David Adkins and His Descendants

David Adkins lived and was probably a native of Giles County, Virginia. There is no evidence that he ever came to this section, but several members of his family did come here, and so far as known, all of them settled on Mud River, a few miles above Hamlin in Lincoln County. Three of his sons Mark, Luke, and John settled not far from each other. They came to Lincoln County (as shown by deeds) about 1818. Their descendants still reside there.

The origin of this family is shown by the <sup>second</sup> marriage record of Luke Adkins, April 24, 1856, in Cabell County. He was then 56 years old, hence, born about 1800. His wife was a daughter of James and Rebecca Snodgrass residents at that time, of Lincoln County, but formerly of Greenbrier County, where she was born about 1803. Her name was Mattia Smith.
