The Last Will & Testament  
Of  
Isaiah Ray, Dec'd.

Cabell County, West Virginia, Sept. 5th, 1863.

I, knowing that all  
men must die, and at present, being of sound mind, I do hereby  
declare this to be my last Will and Testament.

First, I bequeath to my beloved wife, Lucy, all my proper-  
ty, real and personal, during her natural life, and, at her death  
my children shall share alike in my property, first paying all  
just debts.

The above last Will & Testament of Isaiah Ray,

said Will, the same was ordered to record.

Given under my hand this 12th day of December, 1865

Adkins - George Morgan

b. April 19, 1862, son of Tilmon Crockell Adkins, buried at Cedar Cliff Cemetery, on Beech Fork, between the mouth of Raccoon & Forks of Beech Fork, on Beech Fork. He died about 1907, at 86 yrs. He married Zerelda Adkins, buried same place he was.

She died about 1893, at about 76, hence b. about 1817.

He b. about 1821. (Our Bible was burned) Above is probably an error. He was really 2 yrs. older than she.

This would make her born about 1823.

They lived on Beech Fork on Wolf Pen Branch, a few miles this side of East Lynn. & about 3-4 mi. above Wayne C. H. on 12 Pole.
