Resolution to Maintain Campus Autonomy to Regulate Firearms

SR 22-23-28 FS

Whereas, policies that may be appropriate at one institution are not necessarily appropriate at other institutions;

Whereas, each Board of Governors is more familiar with the conditions of the campus for which it is responsible and with the desires of members of that campus community;

Whereas, the Boards of Governors have consulted with their presidents and campus police and have repeatedly determined that allowing firearms on campus poses an unnecessary danger to all concerned;


Whereas, there is substantial opposition on the Marshall campus to the idea of having students and others carrying firearms on campus, as shown by Faculty Senate Resolutions adopted in February 2016, February 2017, February 2018, November 2018, October 2019, October 2020, and October 2021.

Be it resolved, that the Faculty Senate of Marshall University encourages the West Virginia Legislature to oppose any bills aimed at removing the authority of the institutional Boards of Governors to regulate firearms on campus.
