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## CONTENTS AND SCOPE

Ken Hechler served in the United States House of Representatives from the 86th Congress until the 94th Congress. His tenure in office covered eighteen years, from 1959 to 1977. This collection comprises some \_\_\_\_\_ cubic feet of his Washington, D.C. office files, as well as a small amount of material from his Huntington, W.Va. district office.

A sizeable portion of the collection contains correspondence between Hechler and his constituents. Aside from revealing insights into Hecher's relationship with his constituents, much of this correspondence concerns individual black lung claims, social security claims, and employee compensation claims. There is also a file concerning Hechler's appointments of West Virginians to the various armed services academies.

An important part of the collection concerns Hechler's legislative activities. This file contains folders with materials on the various House committees, in which will be found reports, correspondence, notes, testimony before committees, Hechler's sponsored bills, et al.

Of special value is the large subject file on a plethora of topics: black lung, the New River, prayer in school, Vietnam, junk mail, and so forth. Complementing this assortment of useful information are the many other topics found in other files which detail local and state events between the late 1950s - early 1970s: Beech Fork Lake, East Lynn Lake, Silver Bridge Disaster, the Midway Airport Proposal, and so forth.

Hechler's files also include a large file on the various agencies, offices, and departments of the federal government. This file contains correspondence, reports, studies, hearings, etc.

During his tenure in Congress, Hechler maintained a sizeable file dealing with West Virginia. This file has folders pertaining to the various state offices and departments. Details regarding Hechler's campaigns, coal mining, and a file on each of the various counties which made up his district. Among this part of the collection are the files of the Week in Washington Contest, a special program devised by Hechler to help high school students see the federal government working in a first-hand view.

Finally, Hechler's staff compiled a large number of scrapbooks which detailed his activities while in Congress. These revealing and informative volumes are included as part of the collection.

## BIOGRAPHY

Ken Hechler was born on September 20, 1914 at Roslyn, New York, to Charles Henry and Catherine (Hauhart) Hechler, both deceased.

He graduated from Roslyn High School in 1931. Hechler thereafter pursued and received a Master of Arts degree from Swarthmore College in 1935 and a Master of Arts degree from Columbia University in 1936, both of which were in political science.

From 1937 to 1941 he held an appointment as a lecturer in government at Columbia University and Barnard College. During this time (in 1940) he secured for himself a Ph.D. in political science and American history from Columbia University. Between 1940-42 he worked for the Bureau of the Census, the Office for Emergency Management, and the Bureau of the Budget as a personal technician and administrative analyst. He also served as a research assistant to President Franklin D. Roosevelt and Samuel I. Rosenman in 1941-42.

He entered the United States Army as a private in 1942 during World War II and gained a commission the following year. He served in the European Theater of Operations as a combat historian and was discharged in 1945 with the rank of major.

Between 1945-1949 he again served as a research assistant, preparing the 13-volume Public Papers and Addresses of Franklin D. Roosevelt. In 1946 he worked as an administrative analyst for the Bureau of the Budget. Between 1947-49 he held an appointment as Assistant Professor of Politics at Princeton University. From 1949 to 1953 he worked in the White House as a research director on President Harry S. Truman's staff.

From 1953-56 he worked as the Associate Director of the American Political Science Association in Washington, D.C. During 1956 he was the research director for the Stevenson-Kefauver Presidential campaign. In 1957 he joined the faculty of Marshall University as Associate Professor of Political Science.

In 1958 he was elected to the 86th Congress as a Representative of West Virginia's Fourth Congressional District, serving nine consecutive terms. Hechler was a member of the Committee on Science and Astronautics (later the Committee on Science and Technology) and chairman of both the Subcommittee on Aeronautics and Space Technology and the Subcommittee on Fossil Fuels. He served as a delegate to the Democratic National Convention in 1964, 1968, and 1972. He lost his seat in the House in 1976 following an unsuccessful write-in campaign after his bid for the governorship of West Virginia failed.

He served as a Science Consultant to the U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Science and Technology from 1978-80. In 1980 he was selected to be a delegate to the Democratic National Convention, thereafter devoting his time to writing on various subjects and teaching graduate and undergraduate courses in political science at the University of Charleston (1981) and Marshall University (1982-84). Between 1981-84 Hechler was a member of the Board of Directors of the West Virginia Humanities Foundation. In 1984 he again served as a delegate to the Democratic National Convention and, in the same year, was elected as West Virginia's Secretary of State. Mr. Hechler has served this latter post since 1985.

He has authored the following books: Insurgency: Personality and Politics of the Taft Era (New York, 1940); Public Papers and Addresses of Franklin D. Roosevelt (\_\_\_\_\_, 194?); The Bridge at Remagen (New York, 1957); West Virginia Memories of President Kennedy (Baltimore, 1965); Towards the Endless Frontier: A History of the Committee on Science and Technology (Washington, D.C., 1980); Working With Truman: A Personal Memoir of the White House Years (New York, 1982). He also served as an advisor to the film The Bridge at Remagen, which was based on his book.

The organization of the finding is broken down as follows: first, there is a box by box inventory of the collection. The list following the box list contains the contents of the collection broken down into more detailed sections. Both should be used in conjunction with each other to better use the collection.
