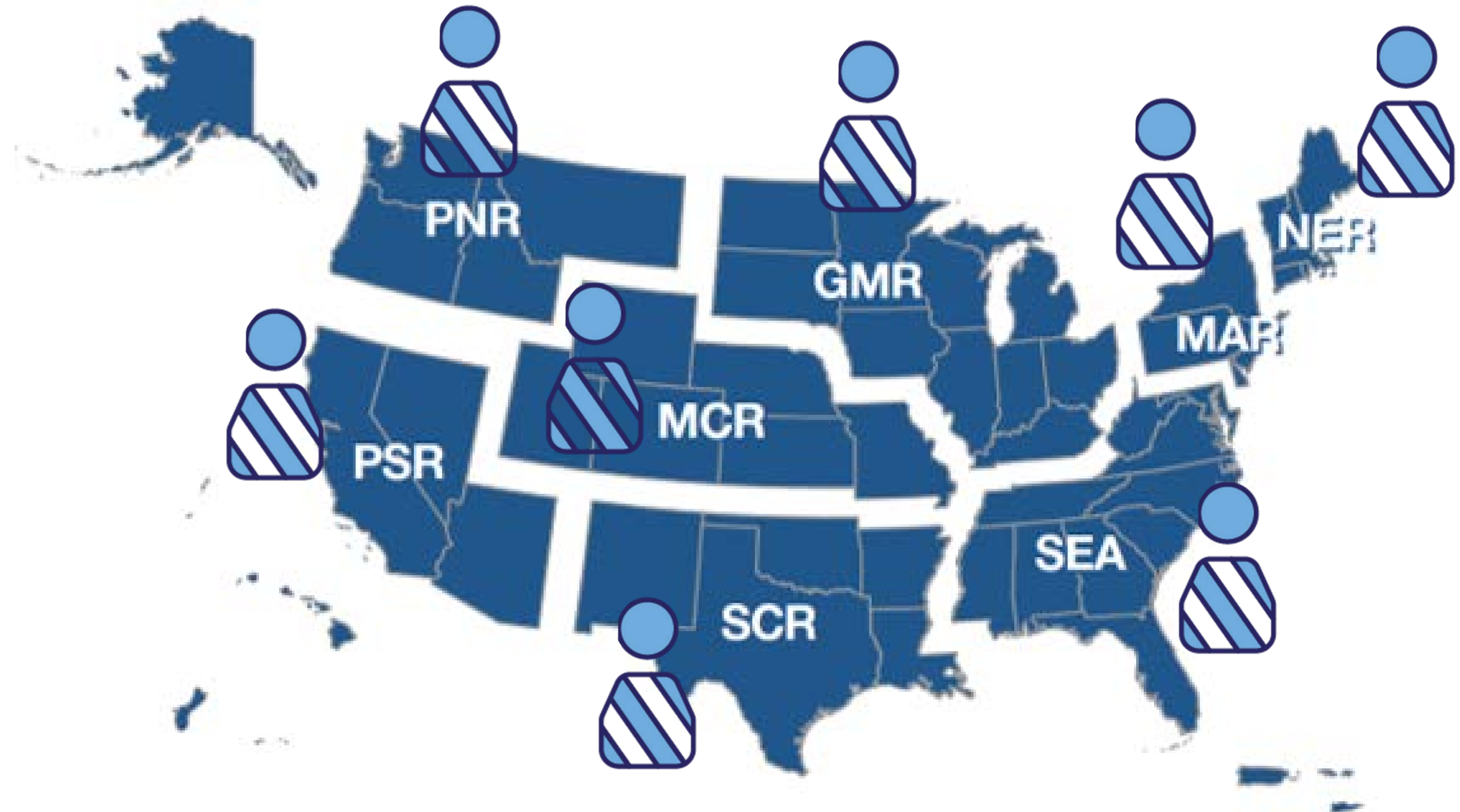

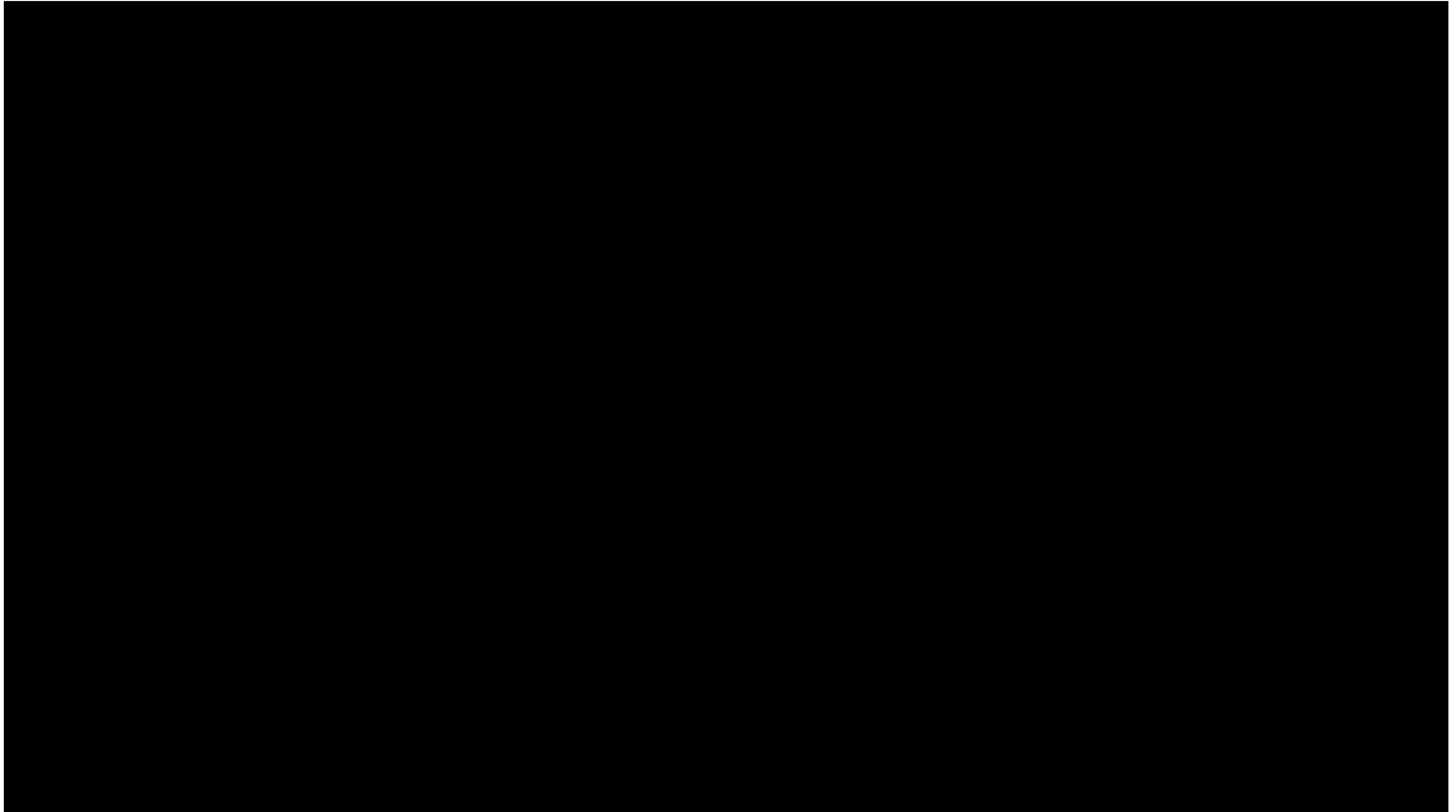

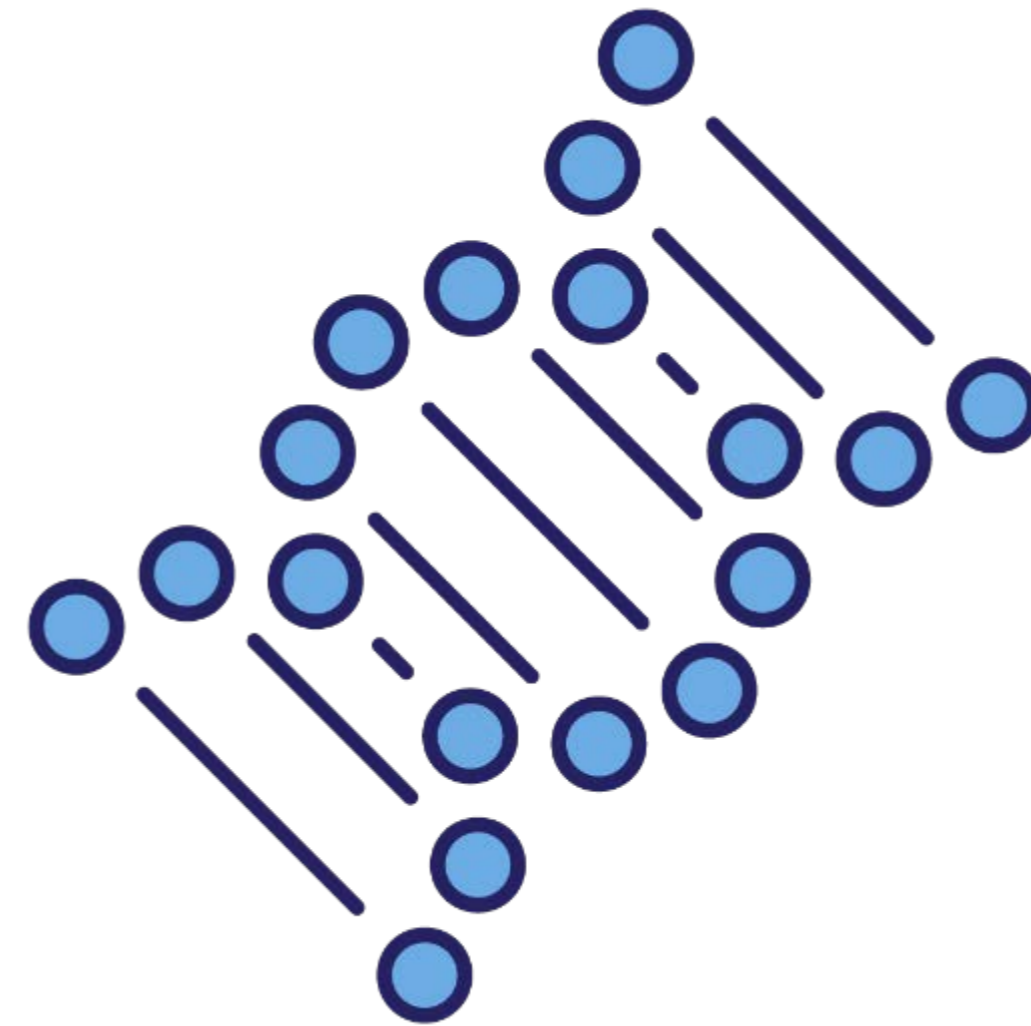
What is *All of Us*?

that is easy, safe, and free to access



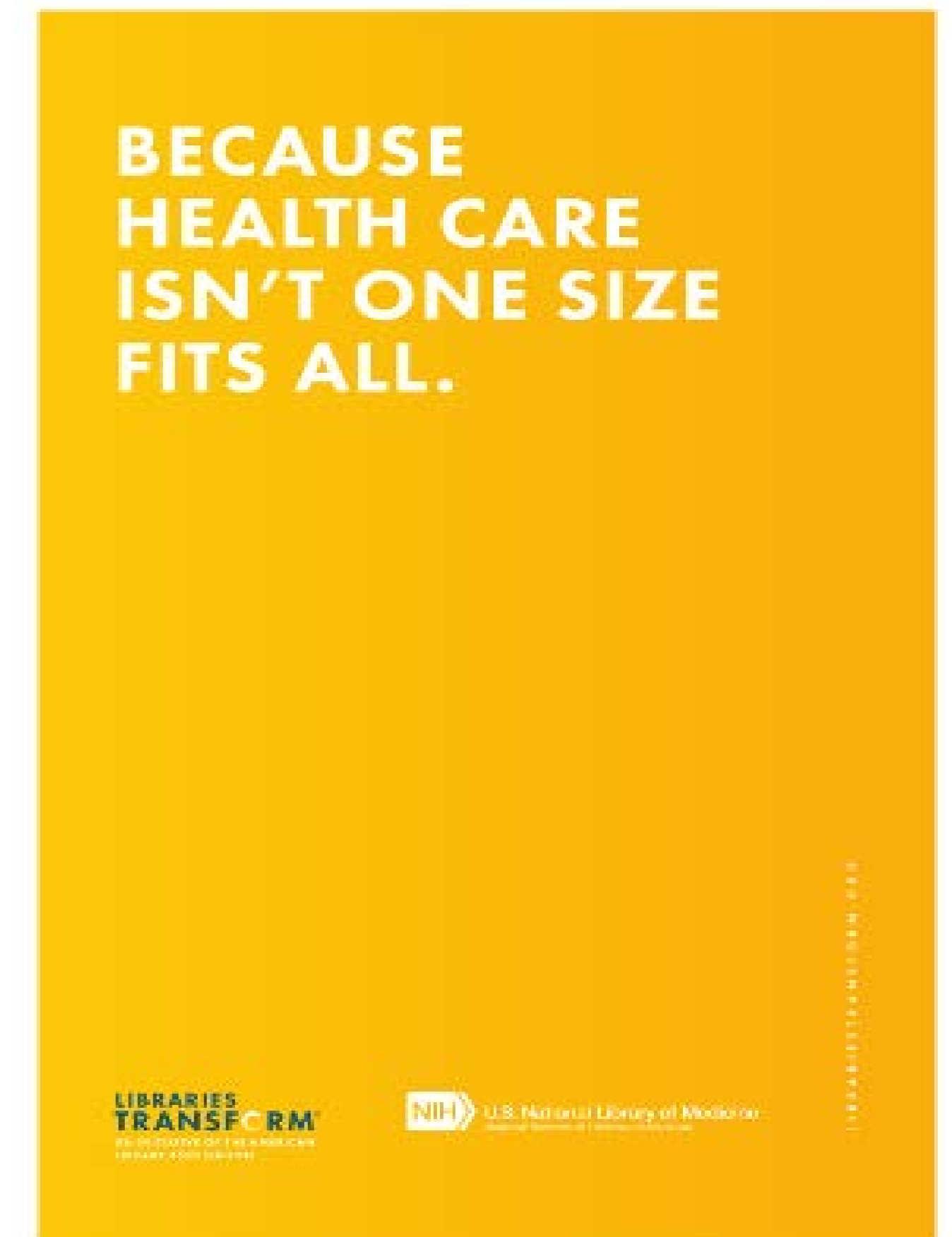

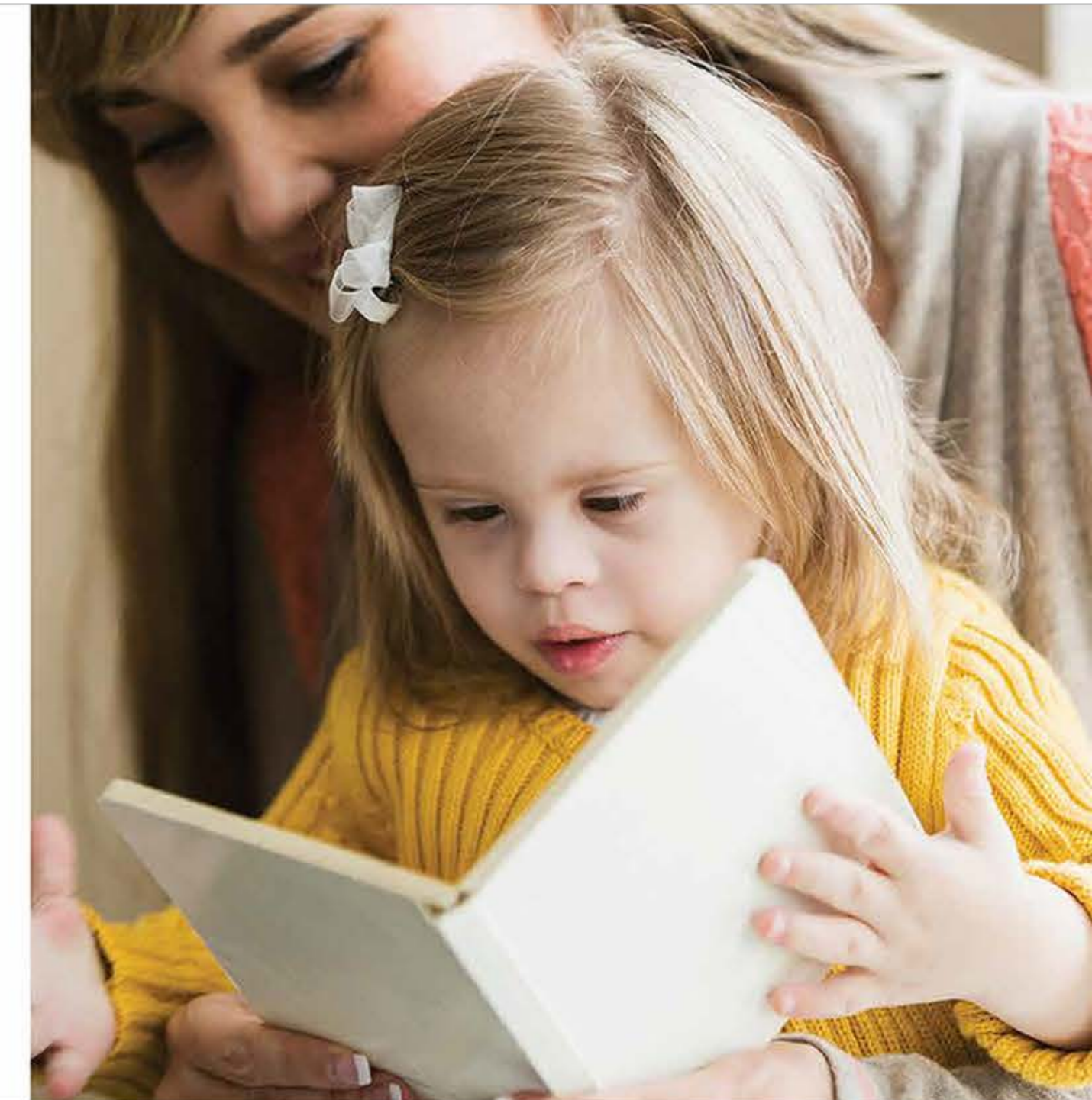


The Value of *All of Us*

- Partnerships

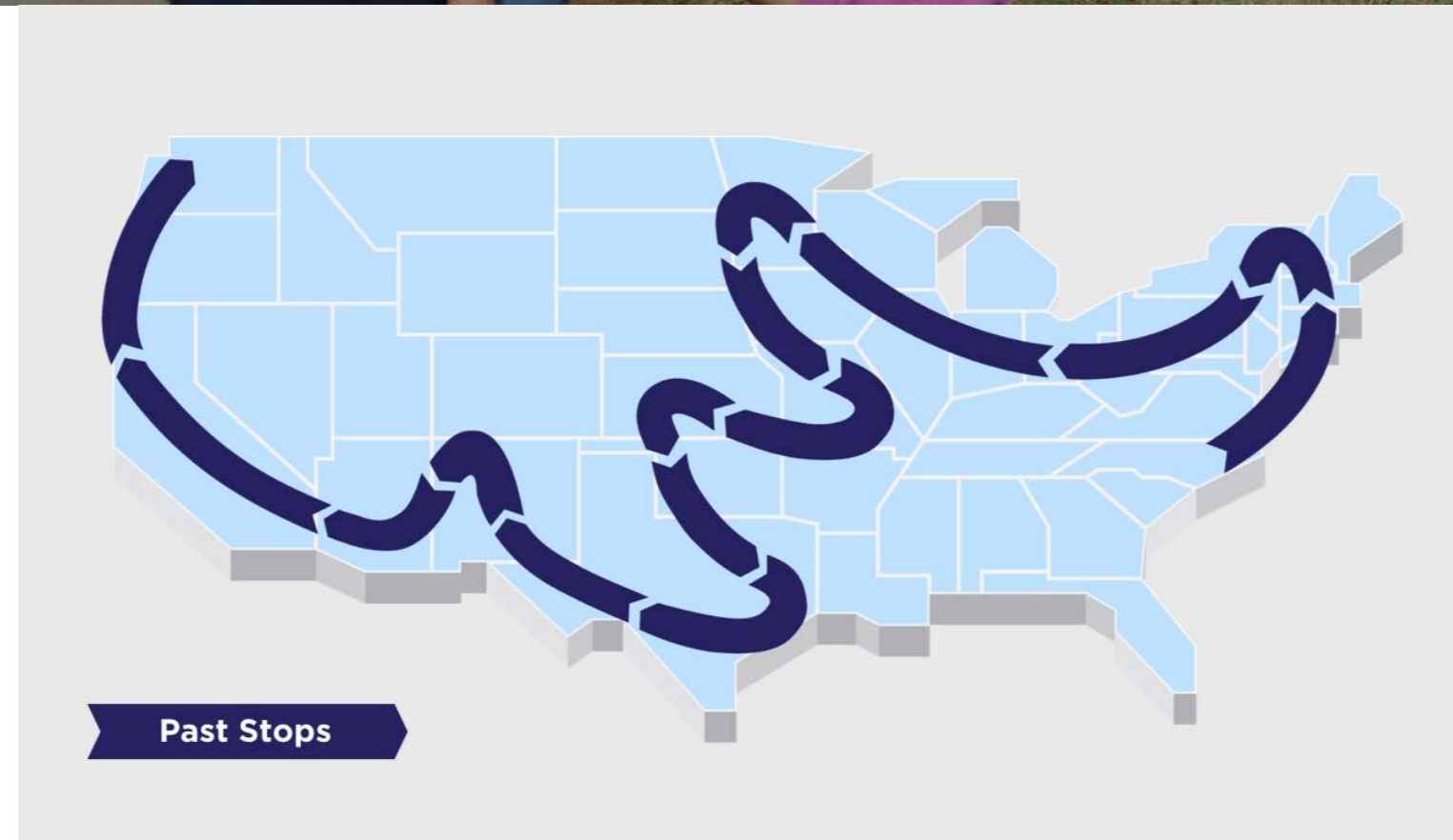
How Can Public Libraries Get Involved?

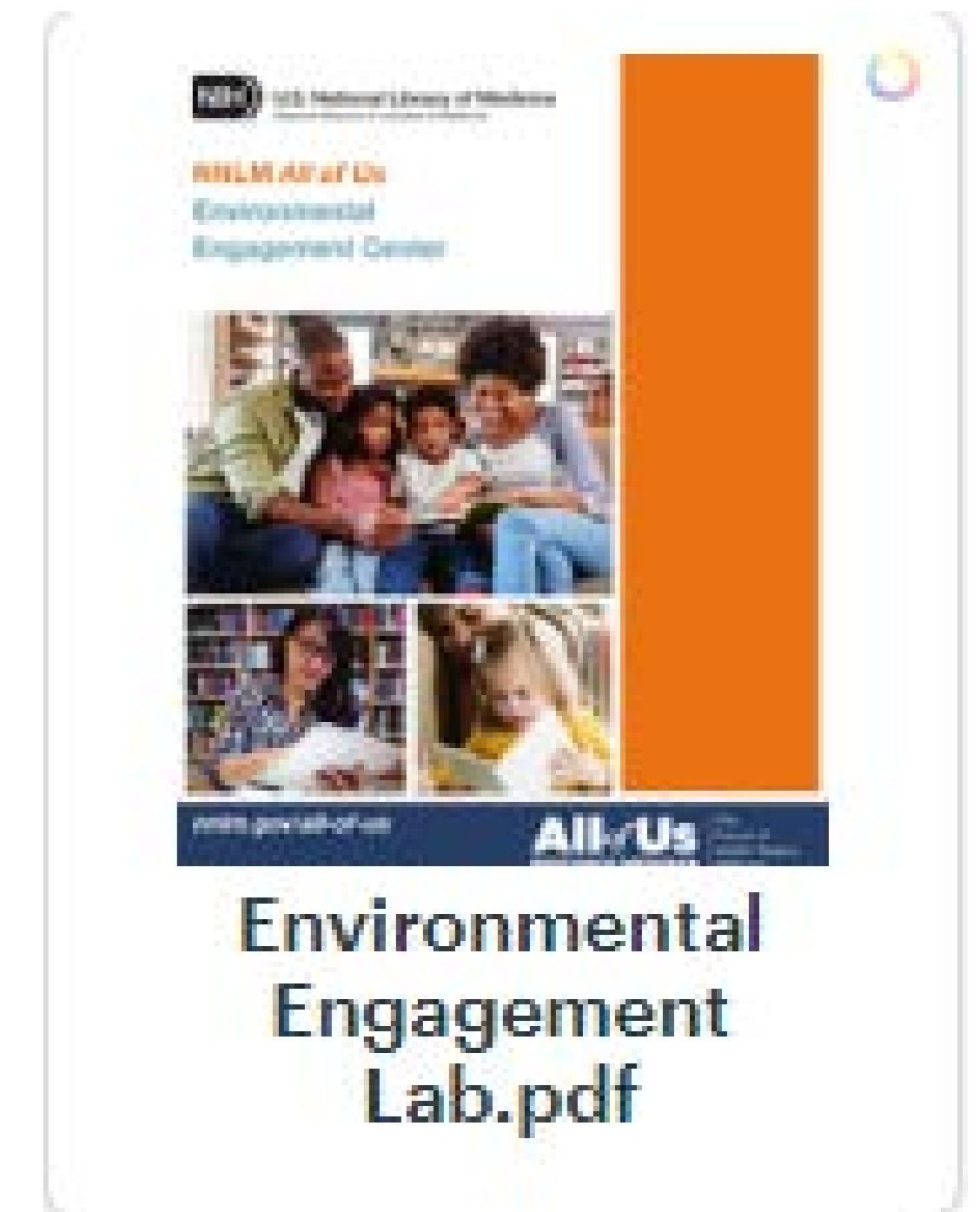
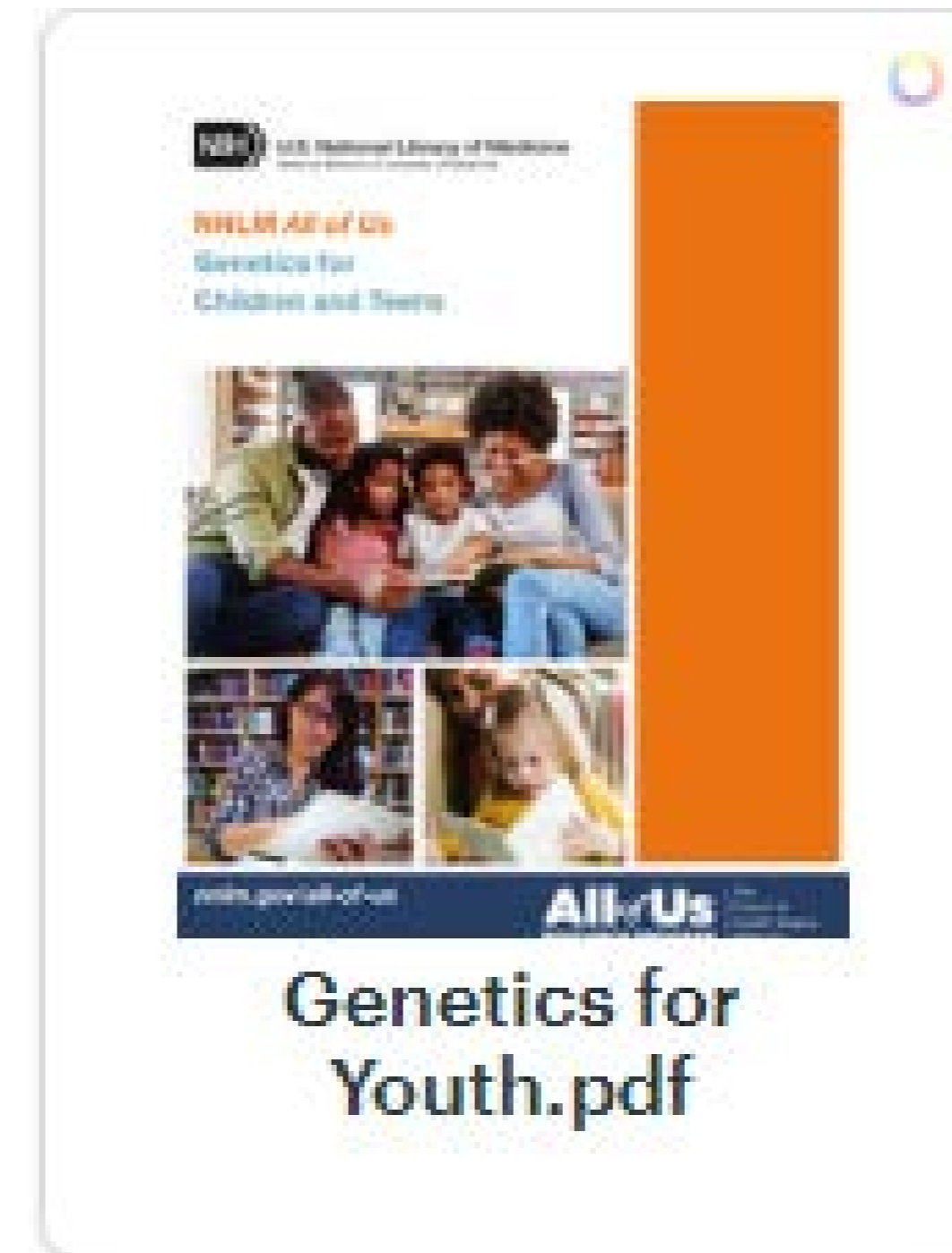
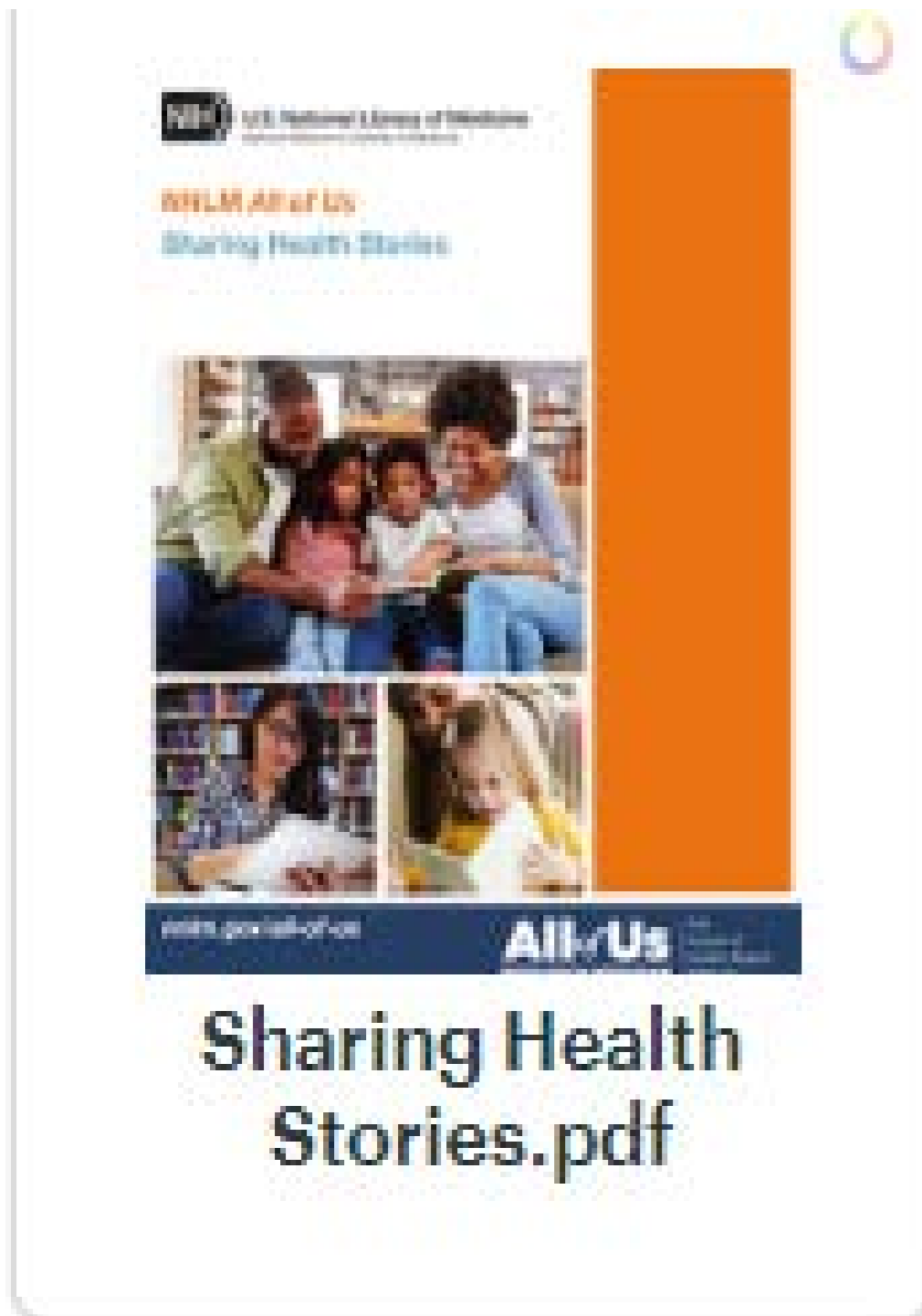
Celebrate American Heart Month with the NNLM Reading Club's newest selections.
