I got into another day fight today honey, and it was kinda rough. You have read about the new jet & rocket fighters that the Germans have, haven't you? Well I destroyed one & damaged two others they look like a drawing from Buck Rogers and they sure are fast, but I have learned how to shoot pretty good with all that practicing that I have

been getting. That makes me ten
destroyed and three damaged. I was
the first pilot in the group to shoot
one down.

I sure would love to see you darling
because you are my inspiration that makes
me do such things. I wish I was there
to love you & protect you and make you
happy. I won't change too much honey
I still have my grin & my sense of
humor. I may not be as shy as I used
to be but honey I sho is eager. I

I won't be home for 7 mas honey
so you had better go & see your folks
but I may get finished by next
spring if the weather isn't too bad.

match mine. And don't worry darling
because what happens just happens
& we can't help it. But your "Zahnie"
will get by as long as I have you.
I love you just too much far words
darling and way time I think about
it I get so emotional I almost
hug my pillow to pieces. I will need
you very much because the things that
we are doing now sure tell on a ~~long~~
move. Well good nite darling &
sweet dreams. all my love.
