The Samuel W. Johnston Family.

Captain Samuel W. Johnston came from Pennsylvania, down the Ohio river, and settled, for a time, at Point Pleasant, Mason County, about 1830, after which he came to Cabell County, and married Rebecca Martin, in 1833. She was said to be a close relative of Andrew Martin, of Barboursville. He was a millwright, and worked first, at Cincinnati, and then, for Sampson Sanders, at Dusenberry Dam, now known as Martha, on the Guyandotte river, two miles from Barboursville.
