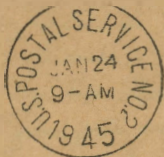

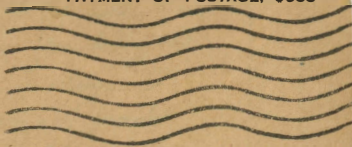

I HAVE FINISHED MY TOUR!! So don't you worry any more about my being OK. I received your picture two days ago and gosh darling I don't see how I'm so lucky. You are the most beautiful in the world. I sure love you darling and I don't mean to wait long before I have you for always. I should be starting home pretty soon. Andy & I finished together that was his second tour he finished with 19 pins to his credit. Don't write any more honey because they won't get here in time. I will have left England by the time that you receive this letter. I am getting the Silver Star and I have been recommended for the Oak Leaf Cluster to it also. I might not get it here because it won't get here before I leave. I have to be presented to us by a General, so I will have to sweat it out in the States. Good nite Darling I'll be see in eye.
