You'll never know how that letter made me feel sug. That was the first letter that I had received from anyone since Feb. If every fellow had something like you for an inspiration well - nothing could stop them.

Darling it sure makes me happy that you are still true to me and when I get home you'll be mine for always. If that's the way you want it. You look mighty sweet in those white shirts. and I reckon you are still eating a lot of grapes and I recon you know "sug". I would give a million pounds to be there with you (eating grapes & more). I have to give you another plane darling because I gave another Jerry \swarrow the heat treatment last week. I blew up a JUNKERS-88

up next to Denmark. on the
North Sea. ^(I haven't learned to spell yet) Muscels & said hello and
the rest of the boys that are left.

The group has lost 46 fellows
but we have destroyed 330 Jaws.
103 of them in 19 days.

I am sure glad that Sie kept
in touch with you while I was
missing. I can't hardly wait to
get home.

I am still the same old Chuck.
to you darling with no changes made
except a few small ones I may look
a bit older and a bit harder and something
else dear I used to love you more than
anything else in the world well I have
changed in that way too.
