Hi Sug -

Sounds like you are having a busy time with Newt Owe. I have thought that the fellows who are over here especially the officers are not paying their Club bills. They are to either pay dues at SI or over here. The amount is the same & since the SI Clubs need the money the most I have encouraged them to pay it there. I will get on the sqdn COs again.

I got an answer back from the USSD and I have written a letter to Gen. Farrell 5<sup>th</sup> ADVON Comdr & one from him to the USSD certifying that I have an emergency. I have asked the Finance Center to send the \$750<sup>00</sup> to my account at the B.O.P. Don't know when it will get there. I'll take the letters up to Osan tomorrow & get them mailed out.
