Hi Aug -

Am sorry about the accident. Still don't know why Capt. Weaver started down through a hole, but the weather wasn't too bad. Maj Sheppard who was #2 in the flight along with #3 & #4 decided NOT to follow because it didn't look too good. Neither Weaver or Lt Mosenstem tried to eject so it may have been a case of misjudgement. It was 7:05 PM, the sun sets at 6:15 PM so it was twilight. This is one of those things that no one will ever know, more than likely.

Sec. Brown has moved his visit date up from the 23rd to the 14th (next Sunday). There is a real good chance that the people & A/C of the 4th T.F.W.S. will be PCS'd to home & given a new name. The 4th (name) would be brought back to S.-J. There is nothing firm on this but we should know in the future. I am going to try & discuss with the Sec. about sending each fellow home over a period to move his family before he is sent P.C.S. The term over here is 13 months with a 25 day leave in the middle. I plan to do everything that

I can't return an wing Code at S-J. nothing is firm just rumor.

I will start tomorrow on ordering my clothes - Two suits - three or four pair of slacks & one or two sport coats.

all of my PJ's have fallen apart so could you send me two pair air mail. size medium is OK, make sure they have long legs & sleeves.

Hope you have your new bed by now & that you have had a dream or two about me. I sure miss you & yours.

I think you & I should just spend the rest of our lives together doing as we please. I just am setting here realizing that I only have 20-25 years more to romance you, when you let me that is!!
