Another of the older Beckett children married a ——— Pine. James Beckett Sr. had a brother William Beckett that married a French girl in Virginia.

A William Beckett lived at Hur-
 riane. He had a son Albert
 Beckett, who was a Captain in
 the Confederate army. The Becketts
 came from England.

Moses Beckett and one of his
 brothers were brought over the Blue
 Ridge mountains in a long sack
 thrown over the back of a horse.
 Their heads were high enough that
 they could talk to each other.

Ezra Beckett says that all of
