20 May -

Hi my sweet little loving wife!
Sorry my drunken friends still call early in the morning. What is Bill Clark doing now? Glad you found out about my pay I had checked on it and got the same answer as you. I attended the 5th AF Order Conference last week and it was a waste of time. All they did was meet about two hours each day then play golf. I came home a day early. They did discuss the final force for Korea. I sure don't understand the idea Millikan has about our A/C, equipt. & people staying here unless he has later word than us. The plan that went from USAF to JCS & then to DOD was for two Guard sqdms (F-100) to be sent over with a wing hq2 to replace the two sqdms 325th & 326th. That are here at Kunsan. The Misawa wing would put an F-4 sqdm at Kwang Ju to replace the 324th. Sure hope Gen Burns can find out something. Tell him to be sure & keep us posted. even on wild guesses.

I wrote to the finance center about the \$750⁰⁰ in USSD. I tried to get them to send the money to you but I got an answer back yesterday outlining all the procedures & it sure is a con of worms. I'm sending another letter with a certification from my Cash. This goes through

the CBPO, then to the finance center for approval
then back to finance is supposed to pay me.
All try to get it put in the bank from finance
at S.J. if possible. I don't know how long it
will take. I will leave around the 30th for
the Phillipines & Viet Nam for 4 or 5 days. Tell
Don to send me a copy of his order so I
can find out where he will be. Sure hope I
get the chance to see him before I return to
the states. Based on the time log best you
go ahead & deal with the bank.

Glad you got Don's uniform strengthened out.
Boy! what an idiot. in the army for 9 months
& don't know nothing. It's going to be rough
on me with him over there for a year. He will
probably shoot himself with his own gun!
Oh well - hope I haven't used all the luck in
the yeager family.

If Sharon comes home & with Mike, Linda &
Sue, then you & I will have to live in the
rattler! I agree on the leave but as I
wrote will have to see what kind of a posture
we will have to maintain when we get back.
Glad the in-laws are all OK. Stay home -
and study all the details of the floor copy, getting
honney again. I expect to spend many evenings
out under the trees with you. Knowing you - you
won't romance under a tree with a bed so handy!!
