Hi Sug -

Enjoyed your letter of the 22nd especially the part about me deciding when I'd had enough of your room! I might get to liking it and never move out. Yes dear, but I can dream can't I?

I think Computer programming would be a good field for Susie to get into. All big companies are using them & I could help her get a good position.

We kicked the 333rd off this AM at 0600. Everything went fine and all 24 of them landed at Guam on time. They are probably home by now. Everybody is eager to head back. The Guard F-100 squad got here yesterday & are getting lined up.

I bought a 12" fan like the big one we brought in Japan. I thought it would fit in the trailer much better. Also I sent a foot locker home with some vases, mals, shot gun, and some clothes but have the clothes passed. I am sending another box home with the 336 with other

things like the salad set
for mom, your glass, a

and pans. and misc items
Howie will explain the Pu-go-gee
