Hi Sug -

I forgot to mention that I talked to Don about the 10% savings and its to the Finance Center and not a bank. He also said that he had signed an authorization for an allotment to be paid to an insurance Co. before he left jump school. But he checked his records at an Kae and it wasn't listed. It takes an allotment about two months to go through so it probably doesn't show.
