John Sharp, Seniar, was born, at Dublin, Ireland, about 1701, and died at new Garden, Chester Pennsylvania, about 1748. (See Immigration of the Irish Quakers, ele. p 333, Pa. 80.) This was about five years before the French and Indian War, and Twenty - Seven years before the Revolution. He married ann Bryan, at New Garden, Pa., on Feb. 16,1726, She was born about 1705, and died about 1782, after the death of mr. John Sharp Jr., son of John Sharp Sr. of Dublin, Ireland was the oldest member of the Sharp family, who came to america, and settled at New Garden, Pa. He came there with his par ents, but moved to Rocking ham County, Virginia, and married margaret Blaine whose parents resided at Rawley Springs. They continued to live there for several years, but moved to the vicinity of Frost, oca. houlas County in order le Seavre land for his large family of six boyand and six girls. Il came to Frost in 1802, He had six sons and Six daughlers: -John Sharp III, Robert Sharp Daniel Sharp, William Sharp James Sharp, Joseph Sharp, Margaret Sharp, anna Sharp, Is abella Sharp, Elizabeth Sharp Rosa Sharp, and Polly Sharp.

John Sharp married Rebeeca moore Robert Sharp died when a young man. Daniel Sharp married margaret Palmer, in Rockbridge Co., Va., and selled on Buffalo Creek, beyond Greenbank. They finally went to Lewis County and sellled on Leading Creek, The record of this marriage is found din Rockbridge Co., Va. The dale is 1804. Daniel Sharp was father of Robert Sharp who was father of Thomas Sharp and grand father of Ollo Sharp. James Sharp married Margaret Wanless, and settled in the head of Thorny Creek. They had five sons and Two daughters: - William, andrew Robert, James, and Lindsey Sharp; Jane Sharp who married nicholas Swadely. Nancy Sharp married James moore
