Hi Sug -

I received a letter from Don today and fired one right back. Sound like he is in good shape and is already looking forward to getting home. Says he is sending 200⁰⁰/mo to the bank & will get 10% interest. I will be trying to go down around the 10th of July. I will be talking to Gen Ryan about it the 4th when he comes thru. Gen O'Keefe said fine.

I received word today that all the 335th made it back. I'm sure you know all about it. and I hope it went as planned. They have slipped the 336th - 48 hours which you can add to the dates & times I gave you. Typhoon problems at Okinawa.

I will be running the 354th Guard wing along with the 4th until ~~it~~ I leave here. It will take lots of work for them to get up to speed, since they have never worked together.

I sure am looking forward to getting home. I know you will get mad at me the first night because of the time change I won't sleep and I will have just flown 9 hours. And I will be home and just won't be able to get enough of you. All of you that is. Oh well maybe you won't be too mean to you ol' daddy after all, this has been an awful long T.O.Y.!! I sure hope you are working on that tan. I lay out at noon each day for an hour & I have the best tan I've had for years.

Don't know if I told you or not but Mal wrote & he got the salad set and was real happy. Hope Andy & I can love him for a couple days on the 1st of Sept. with him.

Wish we were on the Upper Yuba River in the trailer by ourselves fishing ~~mmmm~~
