Mrs. Bertha Woodyard, lives at Proctorville, O. and the youngest son ^{Leroy} lives at Proctorville, O. and the youngest girl, Mrs. Lily Brown lives in Ht. Gu.

Lucy and Manford are dead. Mr. Johnson (Roe) died in 1941 and he lived with us at the time of his death. My husband doesn't remember the Charles Johnson that you mentioned, he was only 7 years old when his mother died - and they moved away from Federal Creek soon after. He is now for Dr. Lugas Wilhoits, I guess you remember him too. My husband will be 63 yrs. old Sat. of this week and we raised 8 children - and in case you attend the Steele Methodist Church in Barboursville, the Pastor, Rev. Paul D.,

Houston. my brother.

Clara, lives on Maple ave. in Stgo - and I believe she raised 6 children. Oran is retired from the W. Va rail mill and has one child. he lives at 18th St near the rail mill.
