Hi Sug -

10 July -

I sure enjoyed your letter. was just full of little goodies. you should shoot the cats head-on - between the eyes!! It doesn't matter about the bed we will let things work themselves out. Don't they make the one that you want anymore?

I see Sharon hasn't changed any. did she use the ticket that was left over from the T.R. or had she lost it? Has she lost any weight yet.

Told the people to fix the truck right. They have a habit of just forgetting about it once they get the money.

The 336th got off on schedule "that with the 48hr delay that is". so they should make it on time. The new flying order 8% got in yesterday & I am teaching them the ropes. Gen. O'Keefe has their wing (354th) attached to the 4th until I leave with the 334th Sqn. So I am responsible for the whole show over here until we pull out. The last F-100 sqdn that came in the day before the 336th left was sure a pretty ratty bunch. They put two of the F-100's in the barrier.

The weather was perfect. I don't know what they are going to do when the runway is wet or the weather is bad. The pilots look more like hippies than officers. Real long side burns & long hair. Oh well it's not my problem.

I will leave tomorrow to go down to see Don. Will take the camera & film to him. May take a few other goodies to him, but they make out pretty good anymore at the base Camp. Magazines & papers are a little late but they have a pretty good selection.

Customs may hold the goodies that Don sends home until I arrive. Howie may have delivered the foot locker in case he does just hold the ^{SUN (MAG'S)} gun & have my clothes passed.

I sure am looking forward to seeing you. This is the longest we have been apart ever and it's not too good.

Am glad you are meeting the squad. They are a fine bunch of people. I read the sad story about the arrival of 335th. God what a tear jerker.
