The Jug -

Your letter of the 17th came thru in three days. Sounds like things are as confused there as they are here on the return trip. By now Gen M. should have delivered my letter and maybe explained the return deal. But in case he hasn't here goes. The 335th departs here at 06:00 Sat. the 29th June This is the 28th your date They Roll at Guam and fly to Hawaii the 29th your date. Leave Hawaii 1 July your date and land at Seymour around 5:45 PM for the first 6th second 6th at 6:15 next 6th 6:45 and last 6th at 7:15 PM. The 336 leaves here 5 July your date & will land at the same time schedule 8 July. The 334th will leave here 26 July your date and land at the same schedule 29 July. If weather is bad in a refueling area the whole thing slips a day. They may make up 30 minutes to an hour on the flight to S-J & land at 4:45 PM. Anyway "stay loose"! The Hq. sqdr will return 9th or 10th July. The F.M. sqdr returns in three parts. 1st one is already there 2nd around 10th & 3rd with 334th.

you forgot to send the map mentioned
in your letter but I would guess it
concerns the parking plan and processing
for the people as they return. They have
to clear Customs and process in before
they can start smooching their wives!
They want to have everything go as easy
& quick as possible for the fellows. This
concerns mainly the support people
who will come to S-J from Alaska & will not
have cleared Customs. The F-4 crew will
have been cleared at Hawaii. So I can
start smooching you immediately - part!
part!

I hope the picture got thru OK and
that you like it. It wouldn't fit in
a drop tank on my F-4 after I wrote
the letter so I sent it on a C-141
that afternoon. (poor planning) or something!

I'll write Delbert a letter & have him
return the \$600⁰⁰ to you which he was to
do as a bribe payed it off. I can't imagine
what he would do at Palmdale for N.A.A.
It's a good place to steal stuff anyway.
He said he cried all the way to the bank
when sunshine went up. I think
Federal will keep on going up as years
go by. hope so anyway.
