She died Sept. 4, 1917,

Mary Rice, who married  
James Newman, and lived  
in Huntington. Diana Rice  
was killed, by a C. & O.  
train, when crossing the  
track, at Qua, a few miles  
above Barboursville. The  
daughter, Mary Rice New-  
man, had no children.  
She was a school teacher.

5-3 Morris Rice was born, in 1821.  
He enlisted, in the Confed-  
erate army, and, after  
the Civil War, he returned  
to the South. He was a  
music teacher, by profession.  
He married a Georgia  
Woman, and they had one  
child. <sup>a daughter</sup>. He is buried

pastor, at one time, of  
Mud River Baptist Church.

"Allen Rice was born, in Bucks County, Pennsylvania, on Oct. 7, 1759. He enlisted early, in the Revolutionary War, for three month service, as a waggoner, under Captain Groves, <sup>or,</sup> and Colonel Proctor, in the State of Pennsylvania. He enlisted for one ~~year~~ month's service, in 1777, as a private under Captain Singer, Col. Irwin, State of Pennsylvania; enlisted in 1779, for seven months, as a waggoner, under Captain Ferguson, Colonel Hooper, State of Pennsylvania; enlisted again, in 1780 for three weeks, as a private, under Captain Thomas, Colonel Robinson, State of Pennsylvania; enlisted in 1781, or 1782, for one month, as private, under Captain Thomas, Colonel Robinson, State of Pennsylvania. He died Nov. 29, 1837.

Allen Rice lived and died  
across Mud River, from the  
present Mud River Baptist  
Church. He married Mary  
Clymer, of Bucks Co., Pennsylv-
