I GOT THE CARE PACKAGE O.K. THERE ISN'T ANYTHING THAT I WEED PIGHT NOW, SO DON'T SEND ANYTHING ELSE. NOW I'M AT A FIRE SUPPORT BASE NORTH OF AN KHE WE RE MOVING OUT INTO OUR A.O. TODAY IT'S NICE AROUND HERE, WEATHER-WISE, EXCEPT IT GET'S COLD AT NITE; IVE GOT A MILD COLD NOW. THERE ARE A LOT OF RUMORS GOING AROUND AS TO WHAT THE 1732 WILL BE DOING NOW - MOVING TO OKINAWA IS THE BIGGEST. I DON'T CARE, AS LONG AS I CAN GET OUT OF THE ARMY IN JUNE. PHAT'S ABOUT IT - NOTHING NEW. I'M FEELIN' FINE. LOVE, Don
