It will be upted that these eye wilness stories don't all agree. They militia were badly scared, and believed all the rumors they heard.

This engagement took place, on July 16, 1861, and was considered the second, or third engagement, of the Civil lear.

This: (One copied) The Battle of Barboursviller In occurry to me that you mughet be interested in some local love. I have had a number of opportunities to obtain direct interviews, with people whose memories went back almost to the very beginning of Cabell County. I have interviewed numerous peasons, born as early as 1830, Some born in The 1820's, and some love as early as 1810. I have talked with many a unione and Confederale soldier I have had eye wilness slories of many events, in the history of the county. It occurred to me that you would be interested in some of these events, so I have decided to give you a few of such descriptions To begin while I will give you some fish hand descriptions of the little fight or I will first gude William L. Johnson 'Samuel Childers, long deceased brought in a report that Union were going to make a raid Through the country.

"about 130 6 140 militia armed with squirrel rifles, gathered in town. It was reported that, if successful, the negroes would take their wives, and carry them into a free state. mexico Smith who claimed he had commanded a company, in The mexican War underlook to command us. He made up a guard from Wayne County, We were in lower trying to get breakfast, when he arrived. a false report stated that the youkees were coming during the neight.
Robert Mays of Beech Fork was singing ing a song in the court house and wash Gilberson, also from Wayne County, sainted, as we came down the slepes of the court house. We had slept, on the floor, the night before. Fifteen or sixteen of Jenline's Mill, and joined us in the fight. which began twenty to thirty min ules after surrise. Mexico Smith our commander placed us on the hill back of the Court House, and at such an angle as to catch every ball that might be fired al us.

Col. Ferguson og Wayne County came running up and said, Gentlemen, you are to fire and then drop behind the hill, and there come up and fire again. Command John Chapman was the first man to fire, and Jon atkins was the second one, but the Youlees, infantry in front and cavalry behind, came up the hill, as if nothing had happened. as they came across the bridge, a man by name of Samuels who was later killed somewhere, ran down with his squad of four men, fired and then broke, to the left, and made a second round, and fired again. Then all trober and ran and decided to do the same. We went into the hills to the right of the Isaac Blake Branch. We were badly scared, and Pees Barbram proposed we divide inte squads The hills, to the mouth of Jours Creek where we crossed the river

and ale breakfast at Colonel Simmons, where alone Havis later lived. The youkees went on to Hurricage Bridge, where Jenkins twined them back. Dave seich fell into the cut and broke a. rib or two! mays, who was afterward killed, was in the fight. my brother and to Ples Barbrane were taken to Camp Chase and died of small pox.
Biel Collins, and two zonaves, were
murdered on Leander Eilkerson's farm, on Beeck Fork. Robert adkens and I were on Robert adkins farm, when we heard the bushwhackers hall these men. Collins lived on Medison the hill; and sow two or them dead. When we got in sight, we saw the bush whackers, in the blue uniform taken from the zonaves. One of then saw that we were about to shoot at them, and said, "Boys, don't shoot, those are our men! He then told some horrid stories, on events in the Beeck Fork sedion, killing wounded personers, etc. Superintendent of Schools, Told of reports that the youlse soldiers would kill women and children.

Dyke Bowen ran into a guller, and splashed mud on hunself and exclaimed, I'm shot, I'm shot." Luckey Savage saw the yankees fix their bayanels, and start up the hill. He said, If they are going to shoot butcher knives, I'm out, and he ran as fast as he was able, destroying gardens as he went. John W. Barbour, who, at that time, lived in wayne County, was about Eix miles away. He heard Col. Joe Mansfield say he'd die and go te Hell, before he'd live under Lincoln's administration. This was at Wayne C. H. Rev. Slephen Spurlock made a Speech at Keyser's slore, on Beech Fork, He said: Boys all go. If you one Southern man is worth six yankees! Dr. moss, of Barbours ville, said the youkees came up the hill, with fixed bayonels. The characterized the fight as a disastrous retreat of row recruits, and that he could hardly Say that they distinguished themselves on that day." The says Col. Mansfield and Terguson commanded the Confederales.

Ben adkjus of Bowens Creek said ! I was on pickel duly, near what is now the 4.40, depot, and had a corner shot out of my left pauls pocket James Reynolds was the only man killed, on our side, mexico Smith lived on Long Branch. John Jessen of Ona said the mililia were under several captains. my captain was blick Lunsford Tomis Creek. mexico Smith and Bill Smith, each brought a délachment from bayne County. Dr. a. B. Mc Gimis of Guyandolle, called himself colonel, and claimed to be the ranking officer. Caplain, afterward. General Jenteins arrived the evening before. The yankees came from Ohio, under Col. Woodwork Woodruff. I wanted to at the bridge limbers, tout Jenleus wouldn't agree. Richard Lunsford excused himself to go home to see about his farm worke.
