This collection consists of negatives from the Huntington Publishing Company, publishers of the Huntington Herald-Dispatch and, until 1976, the Huntington Advertiser. The black and white negatives, primarily 4 by 5 inches, were taken for newspaper articles covering a wide range of topics, including political events, social and civic affairs, sports and accidents. They are arranged in chronological order; the photographers' identifications and numbering systems are employed in the inventory.

The negatives were the gift of Lloyd D. Lewis in October, 1983, and were arranged and inventoried by Cora P. Teel.
