18002 DEAR MOM & DAD + EARYONE-I WROTE ON AN EVELOPE YESTERDAY - IT WAS THE DET BUT THAT OK. HAS SUSIE SMARTENED UP ANY? I'M SORRY AROUT THESE SHOPE LETTERS, BUT I PEALLY DON'T HAVE DO MUCH TO SHY, I TAINK THE MONSOON IS REALLY HERE, BUT IT'S CATE + PROBABLY WON'T LAST AS LONG AS THE NORMAL ONE WOULD. THE OTHER DAY WE WERE MOVING. ALONG THE BASE OF SOME HILLS, 4 HEARD TALKING IN THE BRUSH -V.C. WE HAD AN INTERPRETER WITH US & HE BUD THEM TO CHIEW HOI" (GIVE OVER TO OUR SIDE) OR DIE - THEY RAN + WE FIRED EM UP. THE BRUSH WAS VERY THICK, & ME AND THE LT. + A COUPLE OF OTHERS WENT UP TO CHECK IT OUT. THAT'S THE FIRST TIME I SAW A MAN SHOT. IT DIDN'T BOTHER ME MUCH - HE WAS DEAD THIS NEW GUY + I DRUG HIM DOWN THE HILL THEN LOE LEFT. I GUESS THE GOOKS BURIED HIM. THAT'S ABOUT IT FOR NOW. I'M FEELING FINE & HAVING COTS OF FUN.
