The earliest records on file in this bureau for births, marriages, or deaths begin with the year 1853. We have nothing prior to that year.

The early birth and marriage records beginning with 1853 are indexed but the death records are not indexed. Information regarding births prior to 1853 will have to be secured from early church records, wills, deeds, etc. Marriages prior to 1853 were recorded as "Marriage Bonds," and these records that have been preserved are on file in the courthouses of the State.

This bureau is not equipped to do genealogical research work but will be glad to make a search of the indexed birth and marriage records since 1853 for fifty cents. If a specific date and place are furnished for a death since 1853, a search can be made for a fee of fifty cents. If no specific date and place can be furnished, the charge will depend on the time consumed.


