A poplar and an elm twig soon grew on the graves, and at the time of publication of Hardesty's book were 70 years old and 36 inches in diameter.

The Burrwell Spurlock farm was first settled by Jesse Spurlock quite early in the century. It was  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles from Wayne (North). The family were Methodists.

The Spurlocks & Morrisises both came from Botetourt County. Cassender Spurlock had a brother Wesley who went to the vicinity of Lincoln, Nebraska, and had a grandson — no less than William Jennings Bryan.

Sidney Ray, an engineer on a branch of the C. & O. wrote a book on the Spurlocks. Find him

I knew two of old Benj. Garrett's sons Morgan, and Rev. Holliver Garrett of Northern Meth Ch. & later joined The Southern Methodist Church.

of Beech Fork, about 3 to 3½  
up. Price's Cr. came in  
on East side.
