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The Western West Virginia Chapter of the American Red Cross donated the collection on September 14, 2004.

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Scope and Content

This collection from the Huntington Cabell County Chapter of the American Red Cross spans the years of 1917-2002. The collection was divided into three record group's; administration, programs, and services. The majority of the administration files consist of annual reports and minutes from various committee and board meetings. The program files contain an assortment of fundraisers and campaigns, which includes the annual American Red Cross Ball 1985-2001. The service files offer a variety of information on disaster, blood, and military service to the community including information on the Canteen, which was in operation during WWI. Photographs and slides comprise a large portion of the collection along with scrapbooks and newspaper clippings.

History

The Huntington Cabell County Chapter of the American Red Cross was established in early 1917, due to the efforts of the members of the Buford Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution. Some activities conducted by the chapter included war fund drives, membership campaigns, and a surgical dressing's class, which met regularly at Marshall College in 1918. In March of 1918 the Junior Red Cross was introduced in the county's public and private schools. The Huntington Canteen began operation on September 9, 1918 in a building at the C & O Railway Station. During the year the Canteen was open it served hundreds of solders each day and was one of the best-known and most highly praised Canteen's in the nation.

In 1936 and 1937 disaster relief services were provided when tremendous floods swept through the Ohio Valley.

The 1940's was an important and busy era for the chapter. The chapter provided services to the war overseas; and on December 7, 1943 they purchased the property at 724 10th Avenue for a new chapter house. The chapter also purchased its first mobile unit for \$945, and they participated in their first blood drive. On November 28, 1949 the decision was made to establish a regional blood center in Huntington. The groundbreaking ceremony was held on October 4, 1950, and the blood center was open and ready for donors on March 14, 1951.

During the 1960's the Red Cross initiated the program "Voice from Home", which allowed a member of a serviceman's family to record a message, which was then relayed to the service man by the Red Cross via the "Voice from Home" program.

November 1970 is a date never to be forgotten as volunteers and staff remained on duty for 20 hours following the airplane crash of the Marshall University football team.

With the chapter's continuous growth it soon became apparent that a new and larger building was needed, and on April 21, 1978, the new Red Cross Center at 1111 Veterans Memorial Boulevard was dedicated and opened. From 1978 to 2002 the Chapter's history is unclear.
