# The Davis Family

Daniel Davis pensioned in 1833,  
as a soldier in the Revolutionary War, was born in <sup>Feb. 1, 1759</sup> 1759,  
died in 1838. He served with  
the Virginia militia, at Fort  
Randolph, King's Fort, and  
Toll's Fort. His home was about  
the mouth of Long Branch, in  
what was then Cabell County,  
but now is Wayne County.  
He was buried in the old  
Davis Cemetery, near his home  
on Twelve Pole Creek.

1756 d. March 12, 1817.

Daniel Davis was the first  
settler on Davis Creek. He owned  
a large farm immediately below  
the mouth of the creek.

The Paul Davis home, at first, was on Davis Creek. Later, he moved to Beech Fork, and lived in a house now occupied by Clyde Hensley. It is about half way between Mrs.

Smith's and the mouth of Long Branch, and on the Beech Fork road. The old house stood on the same foundation as the present one. It was a double log house just like the William Bloss house which is just above Mrs. Smith's. His small estate was appraised September 22, 1851. He died on Davis Creek, but was buried at his Beech Fork home. Deed Bk. 1 p. 214, gives his wife's name, on April 18, 1812, as Elizabeth, was her name Mary Elizabeth?

Paul and Elizabeth Davis, at this time made quit claim deeds to 50 acres of land each to William and Paul Davis. William Davis' land adjoined that of his father. Paul Davis' was on the east side of Beech Fork, below the mouth of Long Branch
