**BUDGET & ACADEMIC POLICY COMMITTEE
RECOMMENDATION**

SR-06-07-03 BAPC

Recommends that the University adopt the attached Academic Calendar 2007-2008 and the Academic Calendar 2008-2009 in which the Thanksgiving/Fall Break remains extended to five (5) days.

RATIONALE:

The Academic Calendar continues essentially unchanged in 2007 and 2008. The five (5) day Thanksgiving/Fall Break continues at the request of the Student Government Association even though the five day holiday results in a splitting of the final exams period over a weekend. The summer term configuration has been changed to facilitate registration and simplify fee assessment issues.
