Friday, Jan. 11, 1954.

I arrived here last night, after a terrible trip - rain, sleet, snow, ice, darkness, fog, etc. but the latter cleared up - in fact, all cleared after I left Lewisburg. I came on through to Richmond, arriving about 12:30 P. M. My man - a service man from Minnesota, went onto Newport News, at 50 mi. per hour.

The road was fine and almost level, all the way from Lewisburg.
