## CURRICULUM COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

### SR-04-05-(34) 91 CC

Recommends approval of the listed **COURSE ADDITIONS** and the one **COURSE DELETION** in the following colleges and/or schools:

- **COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS**

#### ADDITIONS

CJ 406 Race, Ethnicity, Gender and Crime 3 hours  
Examines the impact of race, ethnicity, and culture within the criminal justice system. Explores minorities and women as victims, witnesses, and offenders. Prerequisite: CJ 200.

CJ 426 Civil Liability Issues in Criminal Justice 3 hours  
This course examines various theories of civil liability that relate to Criminal Justice professionals, the civil justice system, and preventing and defending civil liability claims. Prerequisite: CJ 300 or permission.

CJ 440 Criminal Justice Response to Domestic Violence 3 hours  
This course focuses on the legal response to child abuse, domestic violence, and elder abuse. Examines dynamics of abusive relationships, the effects of victimization, and current research on these issues.

CJ 492 Senior Seminar 3 hours  
Integrates theory with practice; identifies relationship between research and practice of criminal justice. Examines current and future research issues in criminal justice. Capstone Course. Co-requisite: CJ 404 or CJ 423.

#### DELETION

CJ 311 Police Administration I 3 hours  
Rationale: Addition of new course entitled Administration of Justice made this course redundant.

- **COLLEGE OF SCIENCE**

CHM 467 Intermediate Biochemistry 3 hours  
An intermediate level discussion of the biochemistry of mammalian cells. Prerequisite: CHM 365.

MTH 430 Topology I 3 hours  
First course in topology. Basics of point-set topology: metric and topological spaces, continuity, connectedness, compactness, products, quotients. Surfaces and simplicial complexes, Euler characteristics. Prerequisite: MTH 300.

MTH 431 Topology II 3 hours  
First course in algebraic topology. Homotopy, fundamental group, simplicial homology. Prerequisites: MTH 430, MTH 450.
