Dr. Margaret Byrnside Ballard (April 9, 1900-Sept. 25, 1976) was a doctor and teacher, teaching students in the fields of obstetrics and gynecology at the University of Maryland and Johns Hopkins Hospital. After retiring, she became interested in family and local history and traditional crafts including hand sewing and lye soapmaking.
