Warren Harlow is the author of the three-volume set, "Beckley, U. S. A.". He was a resident of Beckley, Raleigh County, West Virginia. He received an honorary doctorate from Beckley College (Mountain State University) in 1970.

#### **Scope and Content:**

This collection contains papers relating to Harlow's work on "Beckley, U.S.A.". They include photographs of people and places around Beckley (both identified and unidentified), mock-ups of front matter for the never completed fourth volume of "Beckley, U.S.A.", printed materials and ephemera related to Beckley institutions or history.

Other materials include personal papers consisting of short form fiction snippets, a newspaper clipping file related to "Beckley, U.S.A." and Beckley history, correspondence related to the donation of the collection, and genealogical materials.
