Biographical Notes:

Richard A. Baumgartner (September 27, 1953-April 4, 2017) was born in Missouri to Ted and Carol Kallas Baumgartner. He graduated from the University of Missouri School of Journalism and began his career as a reporter with Huntington's Herald-Dispatch. Later, he established Blue Acorn Press, under which he published books related to Civil War and military history.

Scope and Content:

This collection is composed of clippings and copies of newspaper columns by Rick Baumgartner written for the Huntington Advertiser dealing with history of Huntington, West Virginia, families and local events. Many were later compiled into the booklet, "First Families of Huntington, West Virginia." The collection is composed of columns published between 1976 and 1979, the first box contains access copies of the columns while the second box contains the original clippings donated by Baumgartner.
