Biographical Notes:

Individuals mentioned in the collection, in decreasing frequency, include Julia Sprague Hovey (August 26, 1836-February 20, 1911), Sallie P. Smith (possibly Sarah, c. 1835), Dudley Irving Smith (October 29, 1841-October 26, 1929), William P. Smith (c. 1837-), Whitcomb Smith (c. 1833-), Bill Smith (same as William?), Abraham Smith (c. 1844-), Irving Smith (same as Dudley Irving?), and Aunt Cynthia. The father of many of the Smiths is Dudley D. Smith (c. 1803-), a merchant. His children include Whitcomb, Sarah, William, Mary, Dudley, Abraham, Rebecca, and Georgia. The "History of West Virginia, Old and New, Volume 2" by James Morton Callahan lists Dudley D. as "a staunch Union man....led to him being extremely disliked in the community, which was strongly Confederate in sentiment," leading him to return to Lawrence County, Ohio, only to later return to Guyandotte, West Virginia.

Scope and Content:

This collection consists of approximately fifty letters from members of the Smith family, located in Guyandotte, Virginia (or West Virginia, depending on the time), to Julia Sprague in Washington County, Ohio during the Civil War. The bulk of the letters are from Sallie P. Smith to Sprague, and many include their original envelope. Topics are focused on personal life and current affairs.

Processing Notes:

This collection was already processed at the time the finding aid was created. No changes to folder titles, order, or content were made.
