**FACULTY PERSONNEL COMMITTEE
RECOMMENDATION**

SR-00-01-(3) 44 (FPC)

Recommends that the Green Book, which currently requires a faculty member to have the appropriate degree for promotion to the Rank of Professor be amended by adding the following language:

“Exceptions to the degree requirement may be made in the case of exceptional artistry and/or scholarship only if the appropriate college Promotion and Tenure committee so recommends.”

RATIONALE:

This would allow colleges greater flexibility in promotions, the ability to hire and retain would be enhanced, and talented individuals rewarded appropriately. This proposal came out of the College of Fine Arts, where its applicability is apparent. However, its applicability is not limited to that college.
