William Warner Jones (May 22, 1922-June 5, 2003) worked as an insurance agent during his life and had an abiding interest in local history, especially on the subject of Blennerhassett Island, the Blennerhassett family, and the Blennerhassett-Burr Conspiracy. Volumes are composed of amateur-bound books of copies of historical documents as well as articles about the Blennerhassetts.

Scope and Content:

This collection consists of materials related to William Warner Jones' research on Harmon Blennerhassett and the Blennerhassett family as well as the Blennerhassett-Burr conspiracy. Materials include research correspondence, copies of historical documents, personal research notes, postcards, and newspaper clippings.
