## **Biographical Notes:**

Harry Gray Clagg (June 20, 1922-December 5, 1965) was a football player, coach, and principal in Cabell County, West Virginia. Beginning in 1950, he was the head coach for the Huntington High School Pony Express. He was married to Eileen Ann Commetto (1925-2002).

#### **Scope and Content:**

This collection consists primarily of scrapbooks, photographs, a playbook, and diagrams related to Clagg's interest in and career as a football player and coach at Marshall College and Huntington High School. Scrapbooks consist almost entirely of newspaper clippings and make up the bulk of the collection. Other materials include football programs, playbooks, photographs of Huntington High School players, personal materials from Clagg such as childhood report cards and ephemera, and post cards, greeting cards, and other material sent to Clagg, usually related to football.
