Biographical Notes:

Himlerville was a company town in Kentucky established in 1919 by Himler Coal Company for the primarily Hungarian workers in its mines. The company sought to create a cooperative company town, but ultimately closed in 1928.

Scope and Content:

This collection consists of photographs of Himlerville, the Himler Coal Company town, as well as scanned copies of photographs of 1937 and 1943 flood damage, and a survey book by George H. Gunnoe Jr. containing detailed surveys of Marshall College buildings by engineering students in 1937.

Processing Notes:

This collection was already processed at the time the finding aid was created. No changes to folder titles, order, or content were made.
