### Biographical Notes:

Ernest G. Tweel (1913-1979) was a Huntington resident. Tweel took over the operation of Nick's News when Nick Aborizk, his wife Hazel's brother, died in 1947.

### Scope and Content:

This collection consists of one scrapbook entitled "History of the Great 1937 Flood as compiled from newspaper clippings by Ernest Tweel". The scrapbook is unique in that it is a wallpaper sample book that has clippings pasted into the first forty pages.

Note: the nature of the scrapbook makes it incredibly fragile and difficult to use. Pages have fallen out and been mended inexpertly with tape and other materials.

This collection was already processed at the time the finding aid was created. No changes to folder titles, order, or content were made.
