Recommends the approval of the following proposal:


Definition of a Minor

A minor is an area of study outside the major department requiring a minimum of 12 semester credit hours for completion. With the exception of college-approved interdisciplinary minors, each academic department/division designates the specific courses or range of courses required for each minor it offers. Please consult the department description in the Catalog for available minors.

RATIONALE: In an effort to encourage a more deliberate development of the minor as a part of students' academic and career planning, the Associate Deans' Council would like to propose the above statement for the undergraduate catalog.

The choice of whether to offer a minor, how many minors to offer, and the exact composition of a minor would be left to the discretion of the department offering the minor. This would allow codes to be assigned to each minor so students could formally declare their minor(s) and departments could track the number of students pursuing a given major.
