Biographical Notes:

Barack H. Obama was the first African American to hold the office of the presidency, which he was elected to in November of 2008. He ran as a candidate for the democratic party and campaigned against republican candidate John McCain in 2008, winning 52.9% to 45.7%. President Obama would go on to serve a second term in 2011 after campaigning against the republican Mitt Romney, winning 51.1% to 47.2%. President Obama chose Joe Biden as his Vice President and Hillary Clinton was appointed as his Secretary of State. President Obama had also campaigned against Clinton in the presidential primary until she ended her campaign and endorsed him.

Scope and Content:

This collection is predominantly newspapers from 2008-2011 and magazines from the same time period. Other items include campaign paraphernalia such as a t-shirt, campaign signs (one covered in anti-Obama graffiti), campaign buttons, bumper stickers, and an advertisement for the coverage of the 2008 election by Arizona Daily Star, and VHS recordings of the election, inauguration of President Obama, and President Obama's first 100 days in office.

Processing Notes:

A majority of the items discarded from this collection were duplicate copies of USA Today, Arizona Daily Star, and The New York Times newspapers and a duplicate copy of Time Magazine dated January 26th, 2009. The newspapers were arranged chronologically and sorted by year into their respective boxes. The same was done with the Time and Newsweek magazines. The American Legion and US News and World Report magazines were placed in a container with the Newsweek magazines. VHS tapes were left in their original boxes with their original labels intact.
