SR-97-98-5 (FPC)

Recommends that no additional funds be put into the continuing merit pool of money until all merit policies have been reviewed. The amount of money available for merit awards will therefore remain at the 1997-98 level. This policy will cover those academic units which fall under the university salary policy Executive Policy Bulletin #5.

RATIONALE: 1) Dissatisfaction with the current merit policy and, 2) sufficient funding is available at present level.
